Reinstatement of Work Search Requirement

- Claimants must be able to work, available for work, and actively searching for work • each week to maintain their eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits.
- From March 2020 to July 2021, claimants were exempt from the work search ۲ requirement due to the economic downturn resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The work search exemption ended Saturday, July 3, 2021, for Regular UI claimants.

Effective Sunday, July 4, 2021, all Regular UI claimants must actively search for work. Claimant work search requirements are listed below.

Register with MWE	Complete Reemployment Activities Weekly in MWE Weekly
Claimants must register with the <u>Maryland Workforce</u> <u>Exchange (MWE)</u> . This is a one-time requirement. To complete the registration:obtain a username/password; complete required questions; create and upload a resume	Each week, claimants must complete at least three valid reemployment activities, which must include at least one job contact.
