# **BEACON for Claimants**

## What is **BEACON**?

**BEACON** is the Maryland Division of Unemployment Insurance (the Division) unemployment insurance (UI) system which includes *benefits, appeals, and contributions* functions. Claimants, employers, third-party agents, and Division staff use BEACON. For more information, see the BEACON System section on the Division website (www.MDunemployment.com).

## What can I do in BEACON?

Most UI tasks can be performed online, 24/7, in BEACON. Claimants can use BEACON to:

- File initial claims for all program types
- File weekly claim certifications
- Submit supporting documents
- Receive immediate claim status updates
- Retrieve correspondence and other claimant information
- Respond to fact-finding requests for information

- Update account details
- Update requests for tax withholding
- File appeals
- Review benefit payment history
- Track and pay overpayments
- Access UI claim information 24/7

### How do I get started with BEACON?
