CANCELLATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requires the U.S. Secretary of Labor to update and publish the Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) tables annually. States must use these tables for as described in the law, including for youth eligibility determinations. WIOA defines the term "low income individual" as one who qualifies under various criteria, including an individual who receives, or received for a prior six-month period, income that does not exceed the higher level of the poverty line or 70 percent of the LLSIL.

This policy provides corrected annual LLSIL levels for 2015 and references the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)'s current 2015 poverty guidelines.

2015 FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

The following chart provides the 2015 Poverty Guidelines, as given by the HHS.

NOTE: For family units with more than 8 members, add \$4,160 for each additional person.

2015 LOWER LIVING STANDARD INCOME LEVEL (LLSIL)

WIOA stipulates that 70 percent of the LLSIL value shall be used for certain WIOA programs, including the Youth program and the Indian and Native American Program. The following chart provides Maryland's LLSIL standards by family size, Local Workforce Development Area (LWDA), and county.

The U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL)'s Employment and Training Administration (ETA) issued Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 10-15 on December 22, 2015, which made corrections to certain LLSIL guidance previously provided. In Maryland, this guidance changed LLSIL levels for **Allegany** and **Washington** counties. Changes are reflected in the updated chart below. All program participants who were determined eligible for services under the LLSIL levels published in the March 27, 2015 Federal Register Notice should remain eligible for WIOA Title I services, even if they would not qualify under the corrected LLSIL levels. All program participants whose eligibility is determined subsequent to USDOL's December issuance of TEGL 10-15 should be evaluated based on the LLSIL levels provided in the July 16, 2015 Federal Register Notice. Any eligibility determinations made using the corrected LLSIL levels on July 16, 2015 or thereafter are and remain valid.
