SUBJECT: Inspection Policy and Procedures for OSHA's Steel Erection Standards for Construction	ISSUANCE DATE: May 3, 2010

Purpose: This instruction describes MOSH's inspection policy and procedures and provides clarification to ensure uniform enforcement by MOSH Compliance Safety and Health Officers (CSHOs) of the steel erection standards for construction.

Scope: This instruction applies MOSH-wide.

Summary

This Instruction implements the inspection policy and procedures necessary for uniform enforcement for OSHA's steel erection standard by field personnel. While MOSH did not originally adopt the OSHA Instruction, it was used to provide guidance to field personnel.



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Action:

1. The Chief of Compliance, or designee, shall ensure that inspections of steel erection activity are conducted in accordance with the policy and procedures contained in OSHA Instruction, Directive Number CPL 02-01-034 (formerly CPL 2-1.34) issued March 22, 2002.
2. Compliance and Consultation Supervisors shall ensure that field personnel are familiar with the contents of this Instruction.
