
REVIEW ON THE RECORD

Upon review of the record in this case the Board of Appeals adopts the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Hearing Examiner.


DECISION

FINDINGS OF FACT

The employer filed a timely appeal to an agency determination which held that between eleven and twelve practicing physicians, who performed medical services at 9660 Belair Road, Baltimore, Maryland 21236, in the calendar year 1988, were employees of Perry Hall Medical Administrative Services, Inc. and not independent contractors within the meaning of Section 20(g)(6)(i)(ii)(iii) of the Maryland Unemployment Insurance Law.
