REVIEW ON THE RECORD

After a review on the record, the Board adopts the following findings of facts and conclusions of law. The Board reverses the hearing examiner's decision.

The claimant was not attending school, does not have any child care or elder care responsibilities that would restrict her ability to accept adequate full time employment.
